1. AIMS and OVERVIEW

Idea Training Camp will be held in three days. This camp is designed to improve the skills to generate creative results in different or fusional research fields. Now, many companies expect PhDs to propose excellent goals in R&D and accomplish them surely. To get an edge on other companies, all the company members are needed to generate highly creative ideas, with working out processes to accomplish the goals. In this camp, you will experience the management methods to put high-value goals and accomplish them in reasonable manners.

2. CONTENTS

- (1) GUIDANCE
- (2) DISCUSSION among all students "What is the competency of PhDs in new AI era?" The aim of this discussion is that each student looks back on your competency and gets an indicator to grow it more.
- (3) PRESENTATION: Introduce yourself and your research By hearing the presentation of other students that research fields are different, you can broaden your horizon on research.

- (4) GROUP DISCUSSION: Refine group member's research Whole students are divided into two groups and each group select 2 research themes among member's research and refine them. All the members are expected to generate ideas, and experience the effect of thorough discussion.
- (5) PRESENTATION of the refined 2 themes your group selected. Pursue clear and convincing presentation so as to other participants in different research fields can understand the value and effect of the research (for example, value of the goal, how to achieve the goal, points of refinement.)

This camp offers a good opportunity for each of you in different research fields to understand each other well. We would like you to RESPECT opinions of other members, WORK ACTIVELY, and deepen your discussion.

- 2. SOMETHING YOU MUST BRING on the 1st DAY
 - (1) Document

Please PRINT your PowerPoint file <u>22 COPIES</u> to distribute to all participants. Printing layout is up to you, but it is better to staple or clip the printed paper.

- (2) Data in PowerPoint file for your presentation (in flash or USB memory)
- (3) PC

PC will be needed when you discuss and summarize the selected theme. Have a talk with your group member about who to bring PC. We will prepare 2 slide projectors, 2 screens, 2 PCs for presentation for all, and a whiteboard.

(4) Data and information related to your research

In case your research theme selected to refine, data and information related to your research is useful through group discussion and preparing to the final presentation. So it is recommended for you to save the data in your PC or flash memory.

About the contents of your presentation on 1st day

1. AIM of this presentation

- KNOWING EACH OTHER SELF-INTRODUCTION
 All participants in different research fields are expected to understand, and try to
 trust each other, and create network.
- (2) UNDERSTAND each research field INTRODUCTION OF YOUR RESEARCH When each participants in different research fields watch and hear other students give their presentation, they can broaden the horizon on science and understand the goals and values of other researches, and it will be helpful to select themes to refine.

2. EXAMPLES AND POINTS OF THE PRESENTATION

Follow the aim mentioned above, please prepare your introduction using PowerPoint. Examples and point of your presentation are below;

- SELF-INTRODUCTION (1 min) We would like to know your background; name, your laboratory, short history, hobby.
- (2) THEME OF YOUR RESEARCH Put down with the expression that it is easy to understand to other participants in different research fields.
- (3) BRIEF SUMMARY OF YOUR RESEARCH (3 min)Show what your goal is, how you achieve it, and which step you are now.
- (4) THE VALUE OF YOUR RESEARCH (1 min) Explain the effect after you have reached your goal. For example,
 - (a) The novelty and value of your goal, impact to the world
 - (b) The academic originality of your method

((5) IMPORTANT CHALLENGES IN THE PROCESS YOU ACHIEVE YOUR GOAL (if selected in the 2nd day), show challenges which need breakthrough, and your idea how to achieve them.)
